This PhD will be a part of the Australian Research Council project 'Women, Feminism and Art in Australia since 1970' lead by Professor Anne Marsh.

The candidate can conduct research in any area associated with women and the visual arts and/or the impact of feminism on the contemporary visual arts in Australia.

Scholarship value \$AUD 26,288 per annum, candidature is 3 years full-time. The candidate must commit to being enrolled full-time in the program and be able to commence at the beginning of Semester 1, 2017.

A secondary supervisor will be appointed from the VCA or the School of Culture and Communication at the University of Melbourne.
